Second annual event highlights faculty work New Online Academic Journal announced (From: *Rivier Today*, Summer 2005)



About 25 faculty members as well as President **William Farrell** attended “Celebrating Faculty Scholarship, Research, and Creative Accomplishment” at Regina Library in April. Designed to showcase and recognize the “active and fertile life of the mind at Rivier College” according to Academic Dean **Dr. Al DeCiccio**, the event drew responses from more than 30 faculty members, who submitted works ranging from creative accomplishments to scholarly articles to children’s books. Regina Library Director **Brian Courtemanche** referred to the collection of faculty work as “the living legacy of our campus.”

Dr. Vladimir Riabov, associate professor of mathematics and computer science, announced the creation of a new Rivier College Online Academic Journal, with the first issue planned for November 2005. The Journal will publish original, peer-reviewed works highlighting developments in all academic disciplines and will also include workshop materials and abstracts of students’ final projects, as well as

information about conferences and other professional activities. All faculty, staff, students, and alumni are invited to participate. The Interim Editorial Board is now accepting submissions via: journal2@rivier.edu.

A number of faculty members who received pilot faculty development grants last summer (2004) also presented their grant results, including **Dr. Sharon Dean**, professor of English and communications who spoke about her work on authors Constance Fenimore Woolson and Susan Cooper; Associate Professors **Drs. Susan Gately** and **Fiona McDonnell**, of the education department, discussed their work on an electronic teaching portfolio designed to promote student-centered learning; **Dr. Mihaela Sabin**, associate professor of mathematics and computer science and **Dr. Andy Gersten**, associate professor of education, spoke about their interdisciplinary project in computer science and counseling regarding “Dragon,” a software program that transcribes speech into print; and **Clifford Davis**, associate professor of art, and **Dr. Martin Menke**, associate professor of history, law, and political science, also presented on their joint effort to improve the quality of instruction by transferring art and history course slides to an electronic format.
