Dr. Naomi Schoenfeld, Department of Education

"Incorporating Operant Conditioning Activities into Curriculum for Teachers of Students with Emotional/Behavioral Disorders"

Abstract: The behavior interventions used in special education today are based on the operant conditioning principles; yet, teacher preparation programs rarely provide students with the meaningful examples of these principles in action that controlled models can provide. This proposal bridges the gap between historical discovery and current practice by providing pre-service special education teachers at Rivier with the opportunity to replicate such early findings using a human operant-responding panel modeled on the components of a classical operant chamber, that students can then use in pairs to condition simple behavioral responses in each other.

Dr. Karen Spohn, Department of Business

"The Value of 'Keeping Faith' in a Bear Market"

Abstract: Socially responsible investments (SRI) like faith-based and secular mutual funds are marketed as "good" investments. The most recent financial crisis and continued bear market highlighted the value of ethical behavior to the investor. In this research project, I examine the financial performance of SRI mutual funds and in particular faith-based funds during the most recent market downturn. In other words, this project attempts to estimate the value of "keeping the faith" in a bear market. In particular, I examine financial performance by estimating risk adjusted returns of SRI funds disaggregated at the faith-based and secular levels. In addition, I also estimate fund flows for both groups to examine investor loyalty during the same period.

Dr. Joel Stake, Department of Biology

"A Microstructural Approach to the Systematic Relationships within the Genus Agaricia"

Abstract: I am collaborating with Francesca Benzoni, Reef Team Coordinator for the Tara Expeditions, and Fabrizio Stefani, researcher at University of Milan-Bicocca, on a project to understand the evolutionary relationships of the species in the scleractinian coral family Agariciidae. We are looking at microstructral aspects of the coral skeleton in addition to the genetic data we have already started collecting.
