Sister Gloria Lemieux, pm, a former President of Rivier and member of the Sisters of the Presentation of Mary, passed away on May 1, 2014 at the age of 90.

Sister Gloria received her Bachelor's Degree from Catholic Teachers College in Providence, R.I., Masters of Arts in English from Rivier University, Master of Theology from Fordham and Doctorate in English from the University of Notre Dame in Indiana. She taught elementary school in Massachusetts, Rhode Island, and New Hampshire before her 31 years of service to Rivier. For six of those years, she served as President and member of the English Department. Later in life, she served as a writer, researcher, and translator for a major computer systems company, and she also developed an education program for the Boston Federal Aviation Administration.

Sister Gloria was active in the Rivier Institute for Senior Education and in 2007 was awarded "Emerita" status in recognition of her exemplary service.
