Tanzania is a small East African country bordering Kenya and Mozambique along the shore of the Indian Ocean. The country faces many challenges—poor infrastructure, low education levels, poverty, and diseases—including a shortage of health professionals and little to no access to healthcare services. Students will participate in a variety of general medical, nursing, and pharmacy experiences, as well as gain a firsthand perspective on global health issues and Tanzanian culture. The trip is open to Rivier undergraduate and graduate nursing students.

Criminal Justice in London

Explore the history and inner workings of the English legal system. Tour London's halls of justice, including Parliament, and meet with local law enforcement. Behind the facades of its classic buildings lie the tales of criminal justice and law. Starting at the near-millennium-old Tower of London, you'll track the evolution of the British legal system, exploring from the inside of the Royal Courts of Justice, the Inns of Court and the Old Bailey, perhaps recognizable from *A Tale of Two Cities* or "Law & Order."
