He will provide executive leadership of the University's finance and operations departments with oversight of financial aid, human resources, facilities and physical resources, and auxiliary services.

"He is a skilled administrator, having worked at several large and prestigious universities throughout his career. Fields previously held key finance positions at Boston University, Suffolk University, and Harvard University. Most recently, he served as Director of Administrative Services at Harvard University's Derek Bok Center for Teaching and Learning, where he was responsible for the strategic management of all administrative, financial, and staff operations.
